For Parents and Players

- 1. Always be positive with your child and their teammates. Emphasize the value of honest effort, skill improvement and fair play.
- 2. Accept a mistake made by a player, coach or official without yelling at him/her.
- 3. Do not yell instructions to the players during a game. The coach is responsible for feedback related to strategy and instruction. All comments made from the stands should be positive and encouraging.
- 4. Establish a respectful atmosphere among the spectators. Do not argue with other parents from your team or from the opposing team.
- 5. Applaud good play, both your teams and the opponent's.
- 6. Make sure your actions and behaviour set a positive example. Encourage sportsmanship and fair play.
- 7. Respect the 24 Hour Rule : When an issue occurs and a party has a resulting complaint to make or an issue to be resolved, they are asked to WAIT 24 hours. Then put the issue in writing, sign and submit it to the appropriate party. Dunwich Dutton Softball Association.
